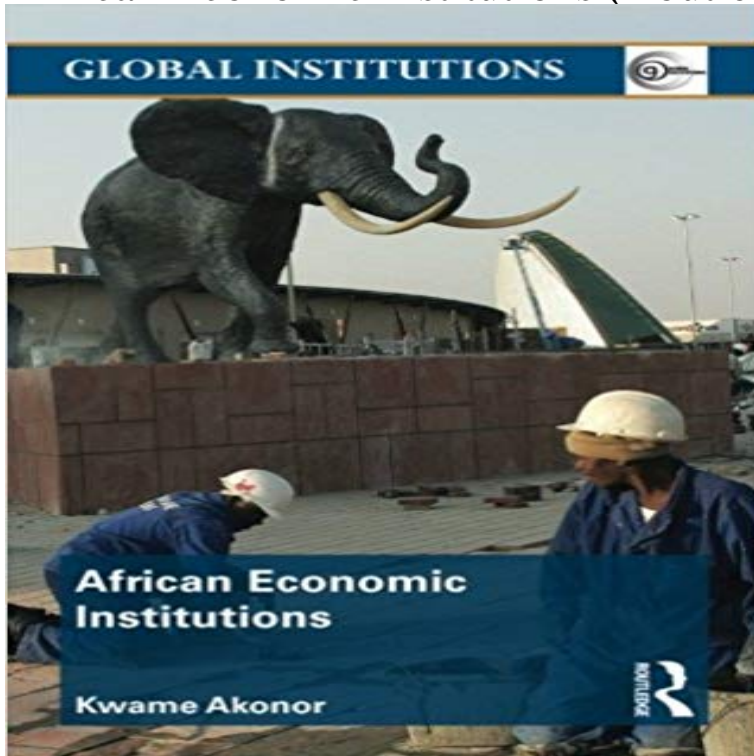


## African Economic Institutions (Routledge Global Institutions)
