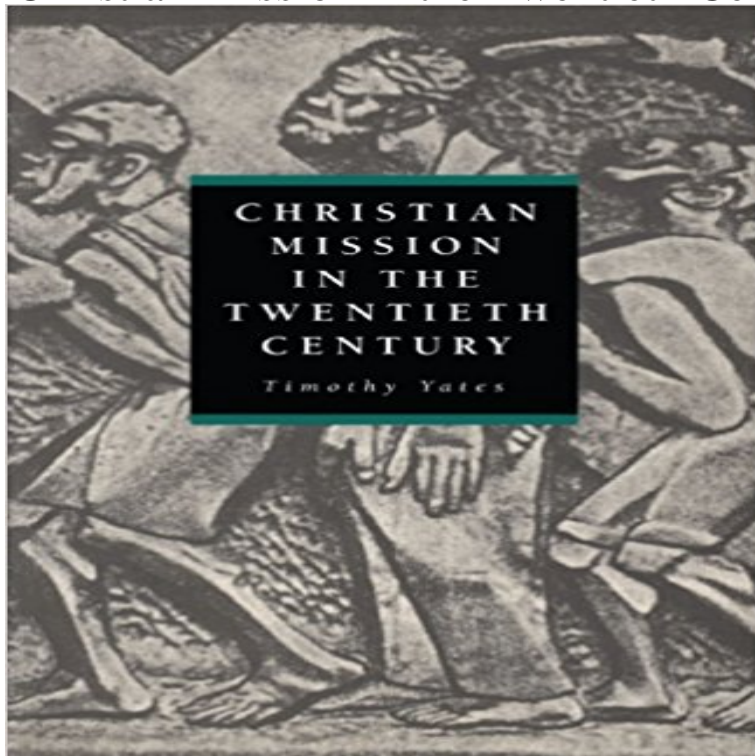


Christian Mission in the Twentieth Century
