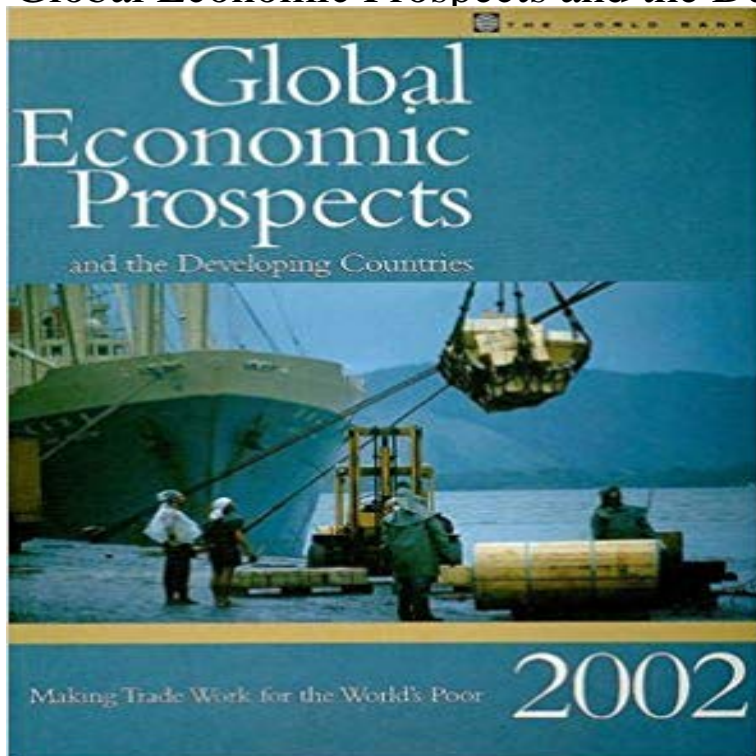


Global Economic Prospects and the Developing Countries 2001
