

CHAPTER XIV REASONABLE AND MORAL ASPECTS OF THE DOCTRINE OF HOLY BAPTISM Throughout this volume the subject of Christian Baptism has been treated from the standpoint of revelation. It has been assumed that God has been pleased to reveal His truth and His will to men, that the revelation thus made is contained in the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, that the words of our Lord are the utterances of a divine and infallible teacher, and that the authority of the apostles and of the other writers of the New Testament has the weight which is attached to the decisions and statements of those who are commissioned and inspired by God. Further, it has also been assumed that the Universal Church, as being the mystical body of Christ and as indwelt by God the Holy Ghost, is the divinely appointed instrument for teaching Christian truth and for carrying on Christian work in the world. To whatever extent the standpoint of historical Christianity thus taken up is departed from, to that extent much which has been said in this little book will naturally fail to be convincing. If this standpoint be taken, and the teaching of Holy Scripture, as interpreted and put in force by the Universal Church, be admitted as the decisive authority given by God to man in all matters of faith and morals and therefore on the subject of Holy Baptism, it will be seen that this Sacrament is not only an external sign, however vivid and picturesque and full of meaning; it must be also a covenanted means of grace whereby the baptized are admitted into the mystical body of Christ and united to Him, are brought into close relation and union with the Three Persons of the Holy Trinity, are
