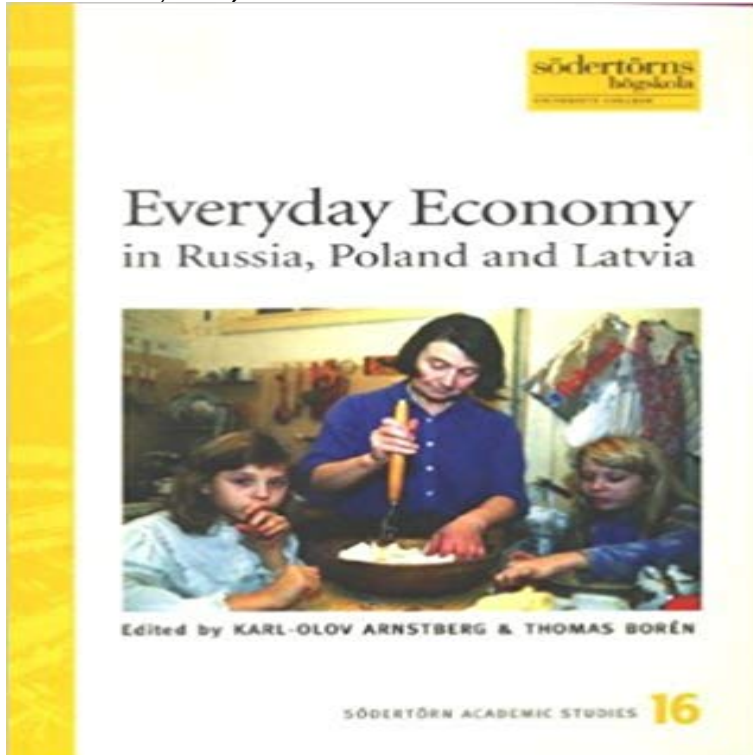


Everyday Economy in Russia, Poland & Latvia (Sodertorn Academic Studies, 16)
