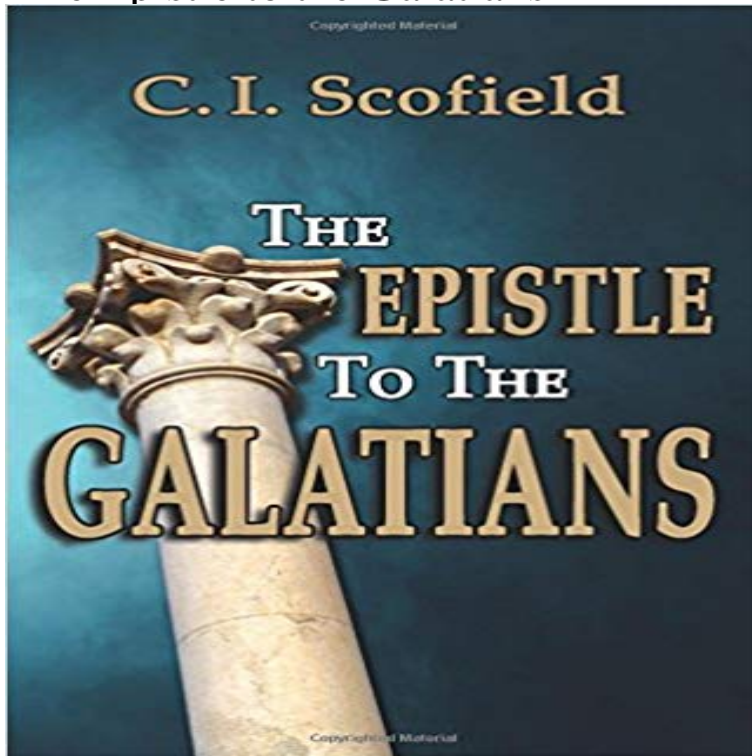


The Epistle to the Galatians
