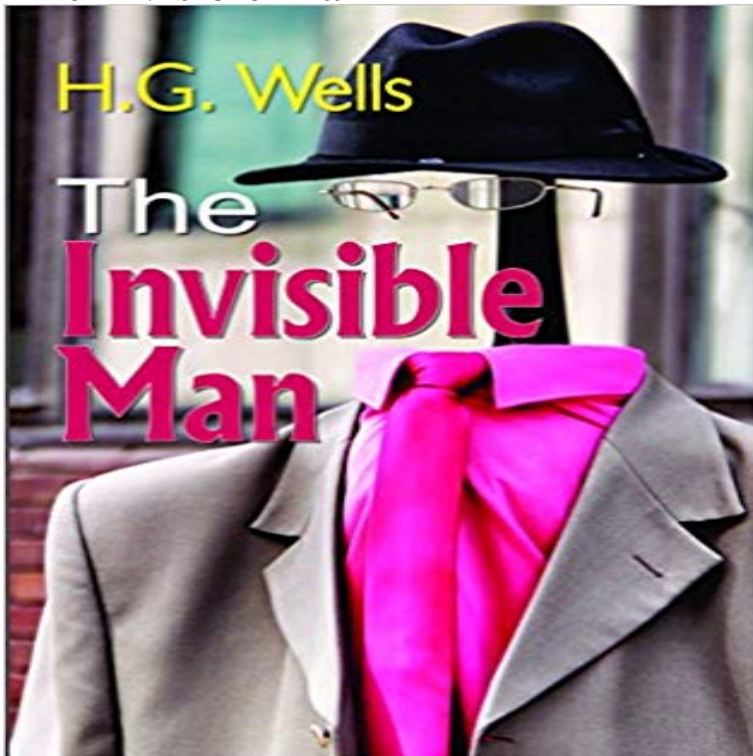


The Invisible Man
