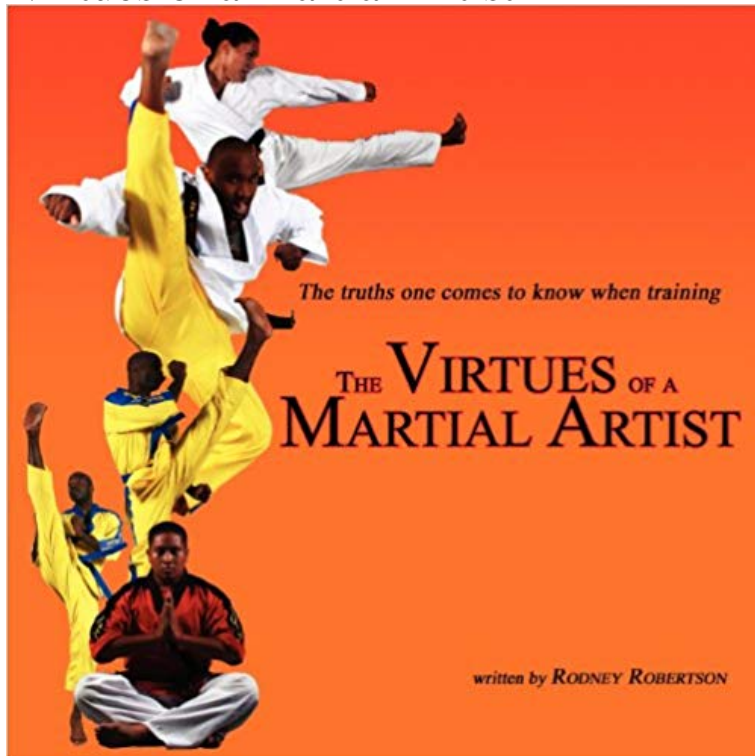


Virtues of a Martial Artist
